Q1) (a) A hires a carriage from B and agrees to pay ₹500 as hire charges. The carriage is unsafe, though B is unaware of it. A is injured and claims compensation for injuries suffered by him. B refuses to pay. Discuss the liability of B. (4 marks)

(b) A gives some cloth to a tailor for making a suit of it. The tailor's charges are settled at ₹5,000. After the suit is ready A tenders ₹5,000 for the charges but the tailor refuses to deliver the suit till A pays an old debt of ₹1,200. Is the tailor entitled to do so? (4 marks)
