Q1) (a) A agrees to sell his scooter to B a month after the date of the contract. But just after 10 days of the contract he sells the scooter to C. Thereupon B sues A for the breach of contract. A contends that he could still perform the contract by repurchasing the scooter from C. Decide the suit. (4 marks)

(b) Explain the rights and duties of finder of goods (5 marks)

Q2) (a) M agreed to purchase certain shares from J on a particular date and subsequently declined to purchase them on that date. The difference between contract price and market price on that date was ₹1, 09, 218. J later on sold those shares and the actual loss amounted ₹ 79, 862. J sued M claiming ₹1, 09, 218 as damages. The courts held that he was entitled to ₹ 1, 09, 218. Discuss (4 marks)

(b) Are the following contingent contracts? (2 marks)

(i) A agrees to deliver 100 bags of wheat and B agrees to pay the price only afterwards

(ii) A contracts to pay B ₹100,000 if B's house is burnt.
